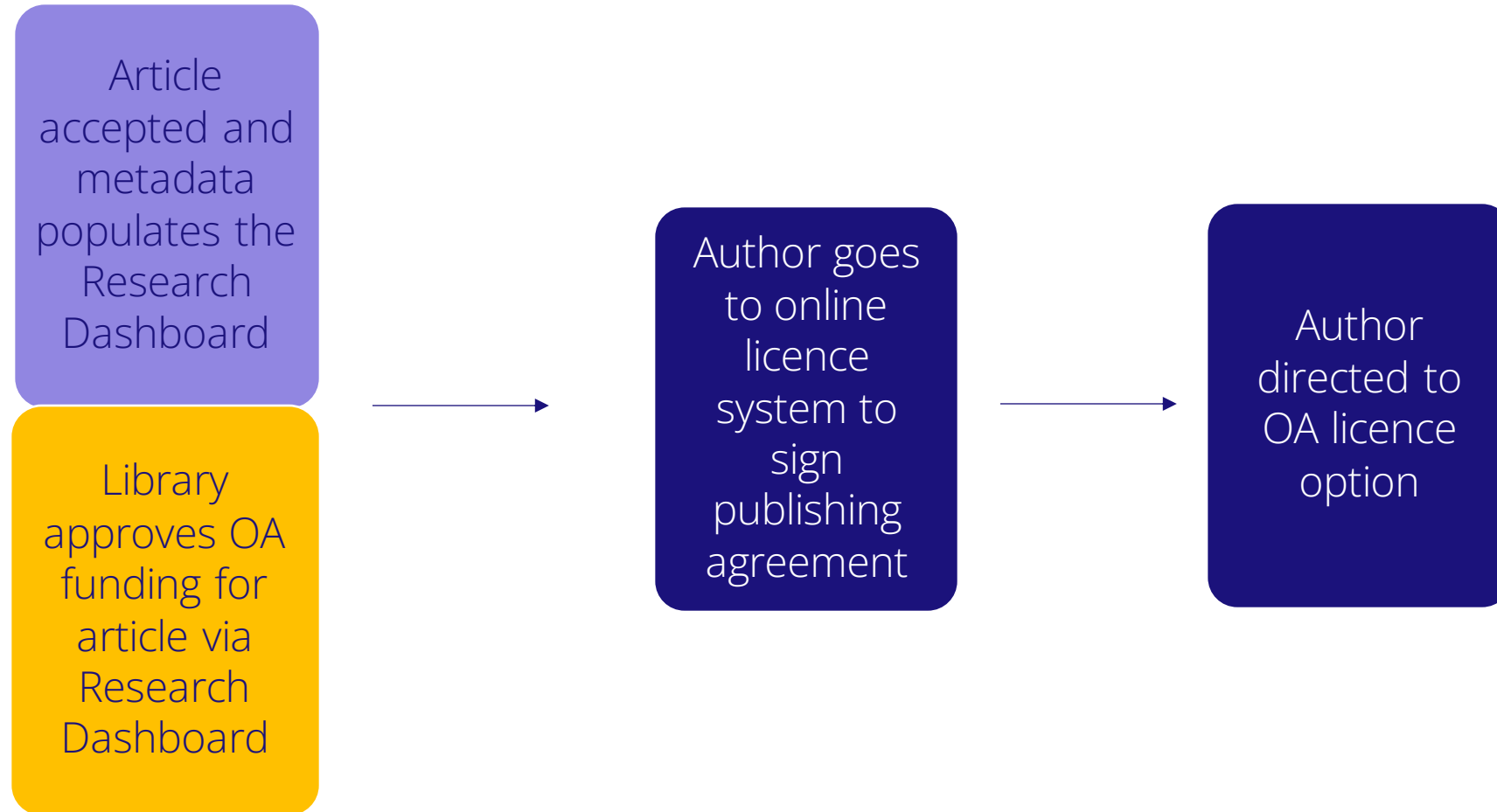

Workflow for an Open Select Article at Taylor & Francis



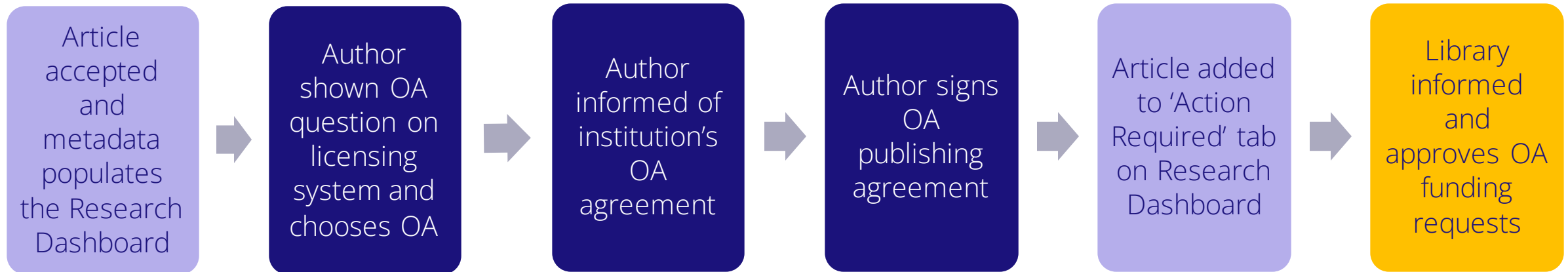



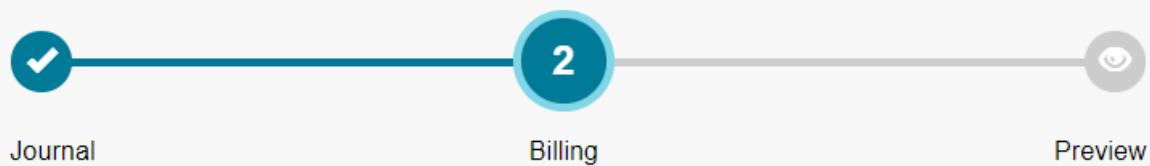
