The modules «Specialisation Part 1», «Specialisation Part 2» and «Bachelor Thesis» are credited with 10 ECTS each, all others with 5 ECTS each.

Context: Students are required to complete 10 ECTS credits in Context. Students can choose from a range of 2 ECTS to 5 ECTS credit courses from a Context Courses Pool, comprising of Languages and General Education courses.
IM students are required to have a **minimum of 5 ECTS** Context Credits in **languages**.
Context Credits can be accumulated throughout the study programme, starting from the 3rd Semester. The courses are offered during the normal semester times, during the summer or other block weeks. The offer is subject to change.

*** Work experience credits for part-time students:** Students, working a minimum 50% FTE during their studies, can receive up to 15 ECTS credits for work experience. Modules eligible for compensation are marked with an asterisk. Credits can be awarded towards Project Work Module, Focus Module 1 and Context Module 1.
