PART A – INTRODUCTION TO THE CURRICULUM

As of the start of the academic year 2017/18, a new curriculum has been introduced in our School of Business (named “[Curriculum from 2017](#)”). The main change is the existence of block courses consisting of 5 ECTS per block. Important to note is that these blocks cannot be split up. There is no ECTS division for each individual course that makes up the block. For example, the block “Business Maths and Statistics 1” must be taken as one block even if the student desires to take Statistics 1 only.

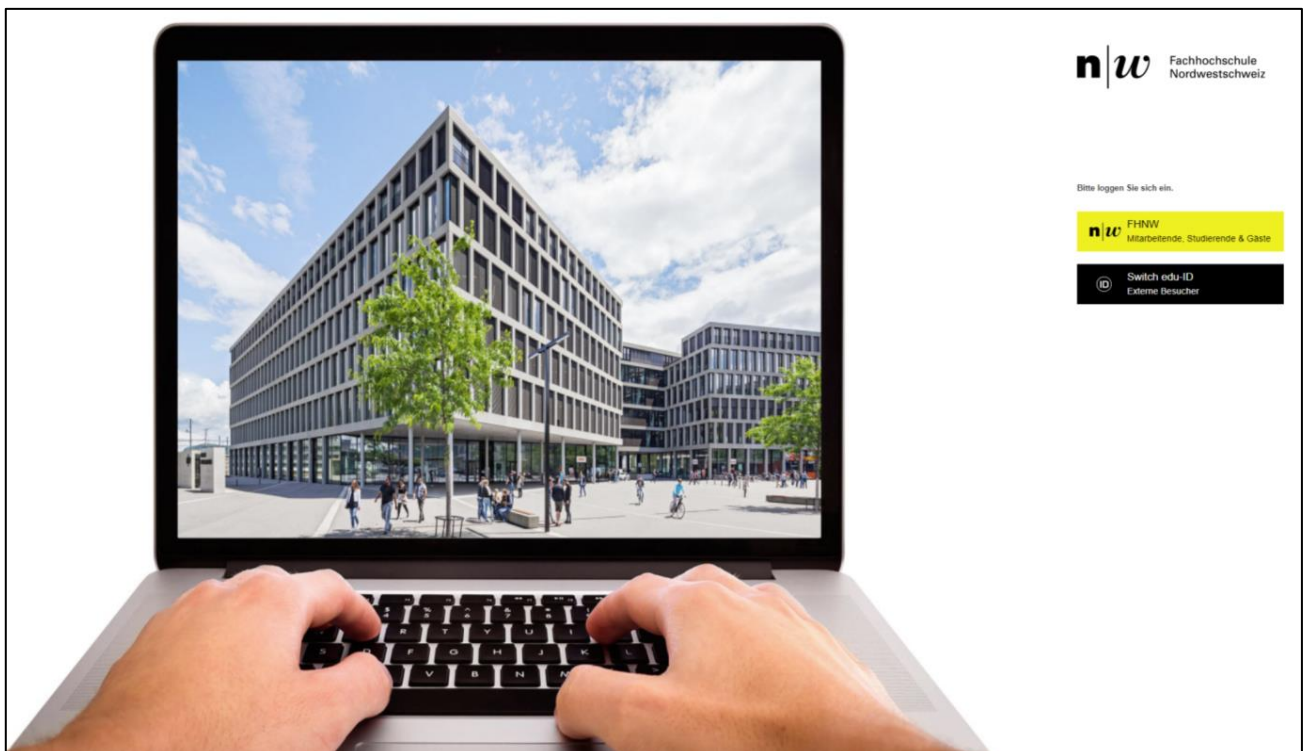

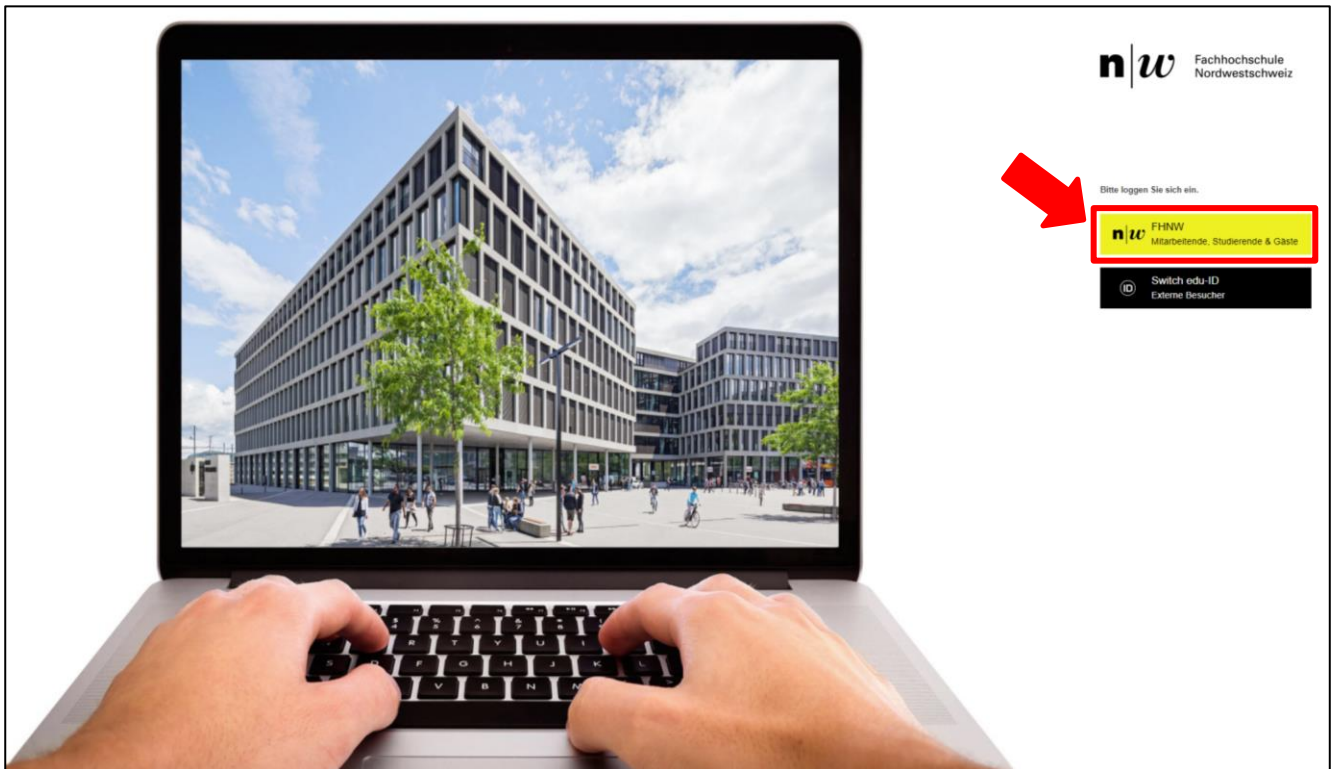
