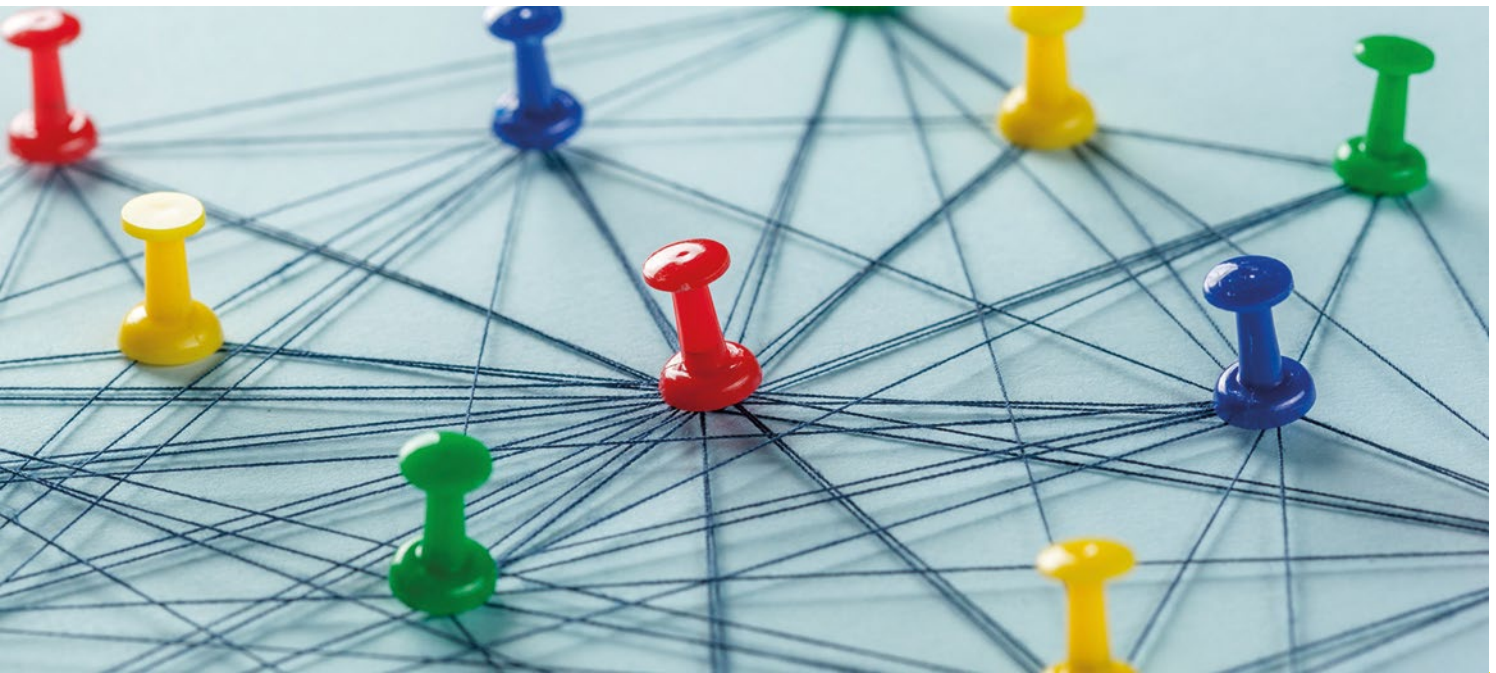




Neurodiversity and coaching

Abstract

Neurodivergent people have become more visible in the workplace of the past few years and evidence on experience has proliferated. What we lack is robust longitudinal analysis of supportive measures and adjustments, where research has been limited to cross sectional self-report data.

However coaching support has a more in depth, mature foundation. Nancy will present what we can learn about Neurodiversity inclusion at work through coaching.
